The Bergen County Players will open the 2010-11 season with Stephen Sondheim's hilarious classic "Company." Performances will be held from Sept. 11 through Oct. 9.

Single man Bobby is surrounded by his "good and crazy people, my married friend,s" who want nothing more than for him to settle down and enjoy the same "domestic bliss" they suffer through on a daily basis. The winner of six Tony Awards features a recognizable score ("Another Hundred People," "The Ladies Who Lunch," "Being Alive"), ushered in a new era of musical theater in America and cemented Sondheim's reputation as the most important Broadway composer/lyricist of the latter half of the 20th century. Oradell resident Ron Siclari is a member of the cast.

All performances take place at The Little Firehouse Theatre, 298 Kinderkamack Road, Oradell. A "Questions & Artists" discussion will take place on the first Friday evening of the show. Admission is included in the cost of the ticket.

There are no performances on Sept. 17 and 18, but special Satur-

day matinee performances have been added for Oct. 2 and 9 at 2 p.m. Showtimes are Friday and Saturday at 8 p.m., and Sunday at 2 p.m.
